  - E. In the event of a disruption, the President will verbally warn the person. If it happens again, the Sergeant of Arms will be asked to remove the person from the meeting, and membership to the club may be revoked."
  - F. "To read: Protocol for Candidates attending Central Texas Republican Women meetings or functions.
    - Candidates may only place their campaign literature on the designated campaign table.
    - Campaign materials cannot be handed out when talking to attendees.
    - No announcements will be made regarding any candidate's upcoming events.
    - All candidates are expected to treat each other with respect. Disparaging an opponent, current Republican office holder, past Republican office holder, or attendees for the meeting is not permitted."
    - F. thru M. Respectfully become G. thru N.
- 8. CTRW 1<sup>st</sup> VP Linda Atkins introduced our guest speaker, Texas Representative Hillary Hickland, HD 55. Representative Hickland shared her background and the reasons she stepped up to serve. She reminded us that we must engage our sphere of influence.
