## **LEGISLATIVE UPDATE – Michele Hercules**

Don't sit this one out! On May 7 local political subdivisions, such as cities and school districts, have their regular general elections for members of their governing bodies or special elections to fill vacancies. Additionally, this May uniform election date will include proposed constitutional amendments passed by the Texas Legislature during its recent special sessions.

### STATE OF TEXAS PROPOSITION No. 1

"The constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature to provide for the reduction of the amount of a limitation on the total amount of ad valorem taxes that may be imposed for general elementary and secondary public school purposes on the residence homestead of a person who is elderly or disabled to reflect any statutory reduction from the preceding tax year in the maximum compressed rate of the maintenance and operations taxes imposed for those purposes on the homestead."

#### STATE OF TEXAS PROPOSITION No.2

"The constitutional amendment increasing the amount of the residence homestead exemption from ad valorem taxation for public school purposes from \$25,000 to \$40,000."

Anthony has been teaching Russian History at Senior University, Georgetown for the past four years and was sought after to support the Aerial Recovery Group in leading the Ukraine orphan rescue mission with timely Open-Source Intelligence (OSINT) in order to provide indications and warning up to the moment of risk assessment, route clearance, and enemy front-line trace in order to keep rescue volunteers safe within the battlespace.
